The Company will reject any warranty requests resulting from high chlorine and/or alkalinity levels, blanket abuse, negligence, and other causes of product failure, including blistering, flaking, and delamination, which are the most visible effects of chemical damage.



#### 3 - Season Limited Warranty, 1-Season Full

The claimant shall pay the following percent of list price at the time of the claim for cover replacement. Freight and applicable taxes extra.

- 0% 1<sup>st</sup> Season
- 50% **2<sup>nd</sup>** Season
- 90% 3rd Season

# **Instructions For Use and Installation**

#### INITIAL INSTALLATION

- Review installation instructions and Warranty.
- Remove cover from box.
- Float cover across the pool fully opened, bubble down.
- Lay cover on pool for 24 hours totally flat to allow cover to settle.
- After approximately 24 hours trim cover to appropriate size.
- If a solar reel system is being added, follow the reel systems manufacturers installation instructions.

#### COVER REMOVAL

- Two people at minimum pull cover from the pool 3 to 4 feet at a time and fanfold in an area adjacent to pool.
- Important to not drag it or allow sharp coping to tear cover.
- Cover post removal should not be exposed to direct sunlight, as such could permanently damage the cover voiding the warranty.

#### MAINTENANCE

- Chlorine levels must always be less than 3 parts per million (ppm).
- Cover must not be placed on the pool for 24 hours post shocking.
- Chemicals when applying, should never directly come into contact with the pool cover.
- The cover should be cleaned regularly using a soft cloth and mild detergent mixed with water.
- Important to clean and dry the cover when is not being used for a period extending over 48 hours.
- Contact pool professionals for guidance as to prevention to excessive sun exposure, knowledge as to proper storage, advice on saltwater pool care, and optimum pool chemistry.

Chemical burns (brittle and deflated bubbles)	Do not exceed pool professional advice for the recommended levels of chlorine, bromine, and other chemicals at any time while blanket is in the pool.	Remove blanket during shock treatment (for 24 hrs.), chemical levels should stabilize to I - 3 parts per million (PPM) before reinstalling the cover. Remove blanket when water temperature exceeds 95F/35C
Worn or torn patches	Do not drag blanket over abrasive coping or sharp edges.	Handle with care. Apply a protective padding over sharp edges prior to cover removal.
Blistering and delamination	Do not leave solar blanket uncovered and exposed to the sun while not in use.	Store blanket in shady area or cover with a sunblock cover for protection when exposed to the sun.
